- III. Decide on a Specific Course of Action to Solve Problem.
 - A. Consider Personal Strengths and Weaknesses.
 - B. Count Costs.
- IV. Take Action
 - A. Don't Dwell on Problem.
 - B. Pursue Only Solution(s).
