Proverbs 28:17

17. “A man who is laden with the guilt of human blood
Will be a fugitive until death; let no one support him.”

Legal or not, the Bible is clear that we are not to support those who shed innocent blood. This of course would include our local abortionists. Certainly they are guilty of shedding innocent blood, as they murder innocent babies still in the womb.

This Saturday marks the 32nd year that abortion has been legal in the United States. The Flathead Pro-life will be holding the annual march for life. We will be gathering at Depot Park in Kalispell at 2:00 in the afternoon and walk through Kalispell to the old court house. Pink and blue balloons, representing each little girl or boy aborted this past year in Kalispell, will be carried by those who are in the march.

While we mourn for the loss of these babies murdered in our community last year, the Bible is clear that their souls went straight to Heaven. Jesus said in Matthew 19:14, “The kingdom of Heaven belongs to such as these.”

Now many have been taught that the babies inherit

Adam's sin, and therefore can't go to Heaven. This doctrine is called "Original Sin". But Ezekiel 18:20 makes this clear statement: "The person who sins will die. The son will not bear the punishment for the father's iniquity, nor will the father bear the punishment for the son's iniquity." So, babies will not be punished for Adam's sin, and exist in a state of innocence and salvation until they purposely sin against God.

So while we mourn the loss of the babies, our greater public demonstration this Saturday is to call our nation to repentance. Our message is that America must change her laws to protect the unborn. History records that any and every nation that practiced abortion and infanticide, even God's won nation of ancient Israel, has been utterly destroyed. May our peaceful public protest hold back the wrath of God towards our nation.

And the march on Saturday is also to call the medical personnel, mothers, fathers, and all who supported abortion in our community this past year to repentance. While the babies who were the victims of abortion are now safely the arms of Jesus, the adults who provide for and support abortion will certainly end up in Hell unless they repent and turn away from their sin.
